

Creating an infographic

DID YOU KNOW

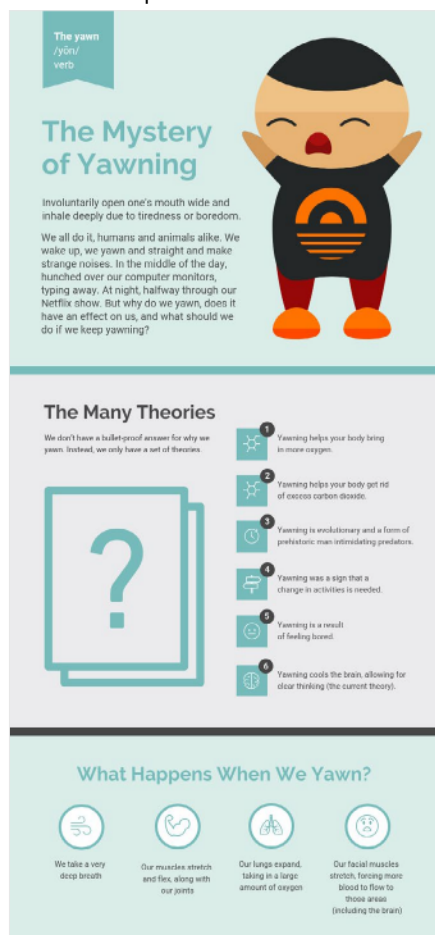
That data visualization means that you display a lot of data in a visual way?

TIP: Try to visualize the subject matter for a test, that is fun learning!



How do you 'read' data? Infographics are a powerful tool to turn data into a story. Infographics are increasingly used to clarify complex information. In a good infographic, text and image reinforce each other. In this lesson you will make an infographic yourself!

EXERCISE 1 - COMPARISON

Choose one of the following subjects:

- A)** Compare two games with the same genre of two game consoles. Which is best?
- B)** Looking for a new phone? Compare two models you could be doubting between. Consider, for example, the price and specifications of the model.
- C)** Compare two sports clubs / athletes / professional gamers. Think of: prizes won, star players, unique qualities, etc.

Collect information about your subject on the internet and process it in an infographic. Use worksheet 1 for this.

EXERCISE 2 - TIMELINE

Make a biography of an artist / athlete / famous person that you find interesting. Include the most important events in this person's life and career in your timeline. Use drawings that make the events easy to understand. Include the correct date and add text where necessary. This can be, for example, fun facts or an explanation of the event.
